### SEPTEMBER 17, 2013

  - Deadline to apply to register to vote –Sunday, August 18, 2013\*
    - Actual deadline is Monday, August 19, 2013

### OCTOBER 8, 2013

First day for candidates filing by petition to circulate petitions for Annual School Election. Clerk shall not count as valid any signature dated more than 100 days before the Annual School Election. Petition must contain at least 20 registered voters who are residents of the school district.

July 2, 2013 – Tuesday

#### **77 DAYS PRIOR TO THE ANNUAL SCHOOL ELECTION**

First day a candidate filing by petition can file a petition of candidacy, the political practices pledge and the affidavit of eligibility with the county clerk.

Filing continues for a one week period and ends at 12:00 noon, 70 days before the Annual School Election.
