### Proposed New Code

**20.34** **SEASON RESTRICTIONS ON STEVE N. WILSON/RAFT CREEK**  
**10-01** **BOTTOMS WMA.** It shall be unlawful to hunt on the STEVE N.  
WILSON/RAFT CREEK BOTTOMS WMA for the 2001-2002 season.  
**PENALTY: \$100.00 to \$1,000.00**

### Proposed Change

**21.06** **ARCHERY/CROSSBOW SEASON RESTRICTED ON CERTAIN**  
**10-01** **WMAs.** It shall be unlawful to take or attempt to take deer with  
archery/crossbow tackle on the following WMAs other than as specified  
herein:

- (A) October 1, 2001-January 31, 2002 within BIG LAKE WMA, DAVE DONALDSON/BLACK RIVER WMA, EARL BUSS/BAYOU DEVIEW, FELSENTHAL NWR, OVERFLOW NWR, POND CREEK NWR, ROBERT L. HANKINS/MUD CREEK RANCH WDA and ST. FRANCIS SUNKEN LANDS WMA, SHIREY BAY-RAINEY BRAKE WMA, W. E. BREWER/SCATTER CREEK WMA and WHITE RIVER NWR (North Unit).
- (B) October 1-November 10, 2001 within GENE RUSH WMA.
- (C) October 1-31, 2001 and February 1-28, 2002, within JOHNSON COUNTY, HORSEHEAD CREEK and CARBON CITY WATERFOWL REST AREAS on DARDANELLE WMA.
- (D) October 1-31, 2001 within HENRY MOORE WATERFOWL REST AREA on SULPHUR RIVER WMA, RED SLOUGH WRA on BOIS D'ARC WMA.
- (E) October 1-December 31, 2001 within WHITE RIVER NWR (South Unit).
- (F) October 1-November 4, 2001 and November 10-December 9, 2001 within RICK EVANS/GRANDVIEW PRAIRIE WMA. Permit required for both hunts.
- (G) Archery/Crossbow season closed on BREWER LAKE/CYPRESS CREEK WMA and WAPANOCCA NWR.
- (H) November 1-December 31, 2001 within BIG LAKE NWR.
- (I) October 1, 2001-February 28, 2002 within BALD KNOB, CACHE RIVER NWR, ST. FRANCIS FOREST WMA and **STEVE N. WILSON/RAFT CREEK WMA.**
- (J) October 1-November 30, 2001 within HOLLA BEND NWR, WEDINGTON.

**PENALTY: \$100.00 to \$1,000.00.**

### Proposed Change

**25.10** **NON-RESIDENT WATERFOWL HUNTING PERMIT**

05-01/10-01

**REQUIREMENTS ON CERTAIN WMAS.** It shall be unlawful for non-resident hunters to hunt waterfowl on BAYOU METO, BELL SLOUGH, BERYL ANTHONY/LOWER OUACHITA, BIG LAKE, BOIS D'ARC, CUT-OFF CREEK, DAGMAR, DAVE DONALDSON/BLACK RIVER, EARL BUSS/BAYOU DEVIEW, ED GORDON/POINT REMOVE, GALLA CREEK, HARRIS BRAKE, HENRY GRAY/HURRICANE LAKE, HOLLAND BOTTOMS, NIMROD, PETIT JEAN RIVER, REX HANCOCK/BLACK SWAMP, SEVEN DEVILS, ST. FRANCIS SUNKEN LANDS, SHIREY BAY/RAINEY BRAKE, ~~STEVE N. WILSON/RAFT CREEK~~, SULPHUR RIVER, and TRUSTEN HOLDER WMAS without first obtaining a Non-resident Wildlife Management Area Waterfowl Hunting Permit for each area hunted by the non-resident hunter. This permit is in addition to hunting and/or guide license requirements as stated in Section 03.00 Licenses. This permit must be in possession while hunting on these Wildlife Management Areas.  
**PENALTY:** \$100.00 to \$1,000.00



## **CURRENT REGULATIONS**

43.01 **VESSEL OPERATION AND EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE WATERS.** It shall be unlawful to operate watercraft on state waters in violation of Chapter 101 Arkansas Code Annotated Sections 27-101-101 through 27-101-312.

**PENALTY:** As provided for in ACA 27-101-104.

43.02 **VESSEL OPERATION AND EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR FEDERAL WATERS.** It shall be unlawful to operate watercraft on waters designated as Federally Controlled and waters under control of the United States Forest Service in violation of the provisions of 33 CFR 173, 174, and 175 and 46 CFR 25 as adopted pursuant to ACA 27-101-107, 203 and 303.

**PENALTY:** As provided for in ACA 27-101-104.

## **DRAFT REGULATIONS**

43.01 **VESSEL OPERATION AND EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE WATERS.** It shall be unlawful to operate any motorboat or vessel or manipulate any water skis, aquaplane, personal watercraft or similar device on waters of this state in violation of any provision of Arkansas Code Annotated Title 27, Chapter 101 “Watercraft” or Title 5, Chapter 76 “Operation of Motorboats While Intoxicated”.

**PENALTY:** As provided for in ACA Title 27, Chap. 101 and Title 5, Chap. 76.

43.02 **VESSEL OPERATION AND EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR FEDERAL WATERS.** It shall be unlawful to operate any motorboat or vessel or manipulate any water skis, aquaplane, personal watercraft or similar device on waters designated by federal law as federally-controlled or under the jurisdiction of a department or agency of the United States Government in violation of any provision of Arkansas Code Annotated Title 27, Chapter 101 “Watercraft” or Title 5, Chapter 76 “Operation of Motorboats While Intoxicated”.

**PENALTY:** As provided for in ACA Title 27, Chap. 101 and Title 5, Chap. 76.
