

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED REGULATION 6.7
OF THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF ELECTRICAL EXAMINERS

Proposed Regulation 6.7 of the Board of Electrical Examiners would provide that experience obtained in violation of Arkansas' licensing law or the licensing law of a sister state will not be considered qualifying experience for the purpose of licensure. Unlicensed experience prior to July 1, 1998, (the effective date of mandatory licensing) would be considered qualifying experience.

**ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS
BOARD OF ELECTRICAL EXAMINERS
STATE OF ARKANSAS**

The Board of Electrical Examiners of the State of Arkansas hereby adopts a new regulation to read as follows:

“6.7 For the purpose of determining experience qualification, the board shall not consider the following:

a. any experience obtained in violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 17-28-304 (Repl. 2001); or

b. any experience obtained in a sister state in violation of that state’s licensing or registration requirements.”

The effective date of this regulation is April 1, 2002.
