7 **A. APPLICATION FOR STATE BOARD EXAMINATIONS AND LICENSURE.**

8 **4. Allowance for Practice Experience.** At the Board's option, on an  
9 individual basis and by majority vote of the Board of Examiners, to  
10 allow for practice experience in examinations, as follows:

11 (a) Applicants with verifiable full time practice experience in  
12 another state, who possess the National Board of Chiropractic  
13 Examiners certification, as outlined in Section A, 2, (e), and two  
14 (2) years of pre-professional college may be permitted to  
15 examination, as indicated by this Board.

16 (b) Applicants graduating from Chiropractic College prior to  
17 July 1, 1971, and with verifiable full time practice experience of  
18 five years or longer, in another state, may be permitted to  
19 examination as indicated by this Board.

20 **5. Transfer of license.** A Doctor of Chiropractic who has  
21 continuously held an active license in good standing in another  
22 state or jurisdiction for a period of five (5) years may apply for  
23 transfer of license and licensure in Arkansas at the Board's option  
24 on an individual basis and by a majority vote, provided, the Doctor:

25 (a) submits an application to the Board;

- 1 (b) has passed either (1) the National Board, Part IV  
2 Examination, (2) the Practical Examination of the Arkansas  
3 State Board of Chiropractic Examiners, or (3) the National  
4 Board SPEC Examination;
- 5 (c) has passed the Board's Arkansas Jurisprudence Examination;
- 6 (d) has attended the Board's New Doctor Orientation Session, or  
7 agrees to attend the next scheduled Session and does in  
8 fact attend the Session; and,
- 9 (e) complies with all other requirements for maintaining a  
10 license in Arkansas and no other reason exists that would  
11 warrant a suspension or revocation of licensure, including  
12 CIN-BAD review.

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14 **E. PROFESSIONAL PRACTICES.**

15 **1. Temporary Licenses.**

16 **(a) Temporary Licensee Requirements and Privileges.**

17 (1) Credentials shall include a completed approved  
18 application, including all necessary validated documents, a  
19 final chiropractic college diploma from a chiropractic  
20 school or college holding status with the council on  
21 chiropractic education or similar standards as provided in  
22 section 2(a), Article A herein and such other information  
23 as the board deems necessary. Applicant must complete a  
24 Jurisprudence examination before approval for a temporary  
25 license will be granted.
