SQUIRREL SEASONS (2004-2005). It shall be unlawful to take or attempt to take squirrels other than during the squirrel seasons as specified herein:

2004-2005 Fall Squirrel Season (dogs allowed):

North Zone: September 4, 2004 - February 28, 2005.

South Zone: October 2, 2004 - February 28, 2005.

2005 Spring Squirrel Season:

May 14 - June 12, 2005 statewide (~~No~~ Dogs allowed ~~for purposes of taking squirrel~~).

EXCEPTION:

(1) In compliance with applicable WMA regulations. (Reference Code 24.04 (Squirrel Seasons Restricted on Certain WMAs.)

PENALTY: \$200.00 to \$1,000.00.
