E. Acceptable Continuing Education:

Only those courses directly related to provision of services and patient care shall be considered for credit. Any course is acceptable which contributes to updating and maintaining the knowledge and skills of the dentist or dental hygienist in the treatment of the individual patient or the management of the dental practice or clinic. Home study courses which include a post-test and the issuance of a certificate of completion will be accepted. CE unites will be determined by the course sponsor.

*At least 2 CE hours in each 2 year reporting period must be on the subject of infection control.* Courses dealing with other subjects of professional concern are outside the scope of the continuing education requirements. Such courses or programs which will not qualify for approval are money management, investments, time spend with professional and/or financial consultants, and professional organizational business meetings. The Board does not pre-approve courses.
