






**WHEREAS,** the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission and its staff have proposed the attached 2015 miscellaneous Enforcement regulation changes; **and**

**WHEREAS,** the attached regulations have been communicated through a variety of media avenues to sportsmen and the general public throughout the state for review and comment for the past 30 days; **and**

**WHEREAS,** after carefully considering the recommendations of Commission staff and the Regulations Committee, as well as comments received from the public, the Commission has determined that the attached regulations promote sound wildlife conservation and management and are consistent with Amendment 35 of the Arkansas Constitution and that these regulations should now be approved for application statewide.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** this 24<sup>th</sup> day of September 2015, that the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission hereby approves and adopts the attached regulations, which shall become effective immediately upon public filing or as soon thereafter as possible.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED** that the Commission staff is authorized to proceed with legally certifying and filing the attached regulations with the Secretary of State, State Library, and Bureau of Legislative Research and incorporating them into the Commission Code Book and Addendum.

~~REFUSING INSPECTION BY WILDLIFE OFFICER PROHIBITED~~ **RESERVED**

~~It is unlawful to refuse to immediately surrender the following items to a wildlife officer upon request for lawful inspection: any killing device, license, permit, tag, stamp, check sheet, ice chest, game bag, game vest, wildlife, fishing tackle, equipment used for hunting or fishing or container that can reasonably hold wildlife.~~

~~PENALTY: Class 1~~

~~INTERFERING WITH AGFC COMMISSION EMPLOYEES,~~ **OR AGENTS**  
~~OPERATIONS,~~ **OR ACTIVITIES PROHIBITED**

(A) ~~It is unlawful to interfere with any AGFC Commission employees or Agents, certified law enforcement officials, U.S. Department of Agriculture or the U.S. Department of Interior employees or designee engaged in the performance of official duties. It is unlawful to knowingly obstruct, impair, or hinder the performance of Commission operations, activities, inspections, investigations, or the official duties of any Commission employee.~~

(B) ~~It is unlawful to falsely identify oneself to a Commission employee engaged in the performance of official duties.~~

(C) ~~It is unlawful to knowingly employ or threaten to employ physical force against a Commission employee engaged in the performance of official duties.~~

~~(B)(D)~~ It is unlawful to interfere, tamper, hinder or alter any Commission, or Commission designee's property, equipment, trap, structure or approved activity.

**PENALTY: Class 1**
