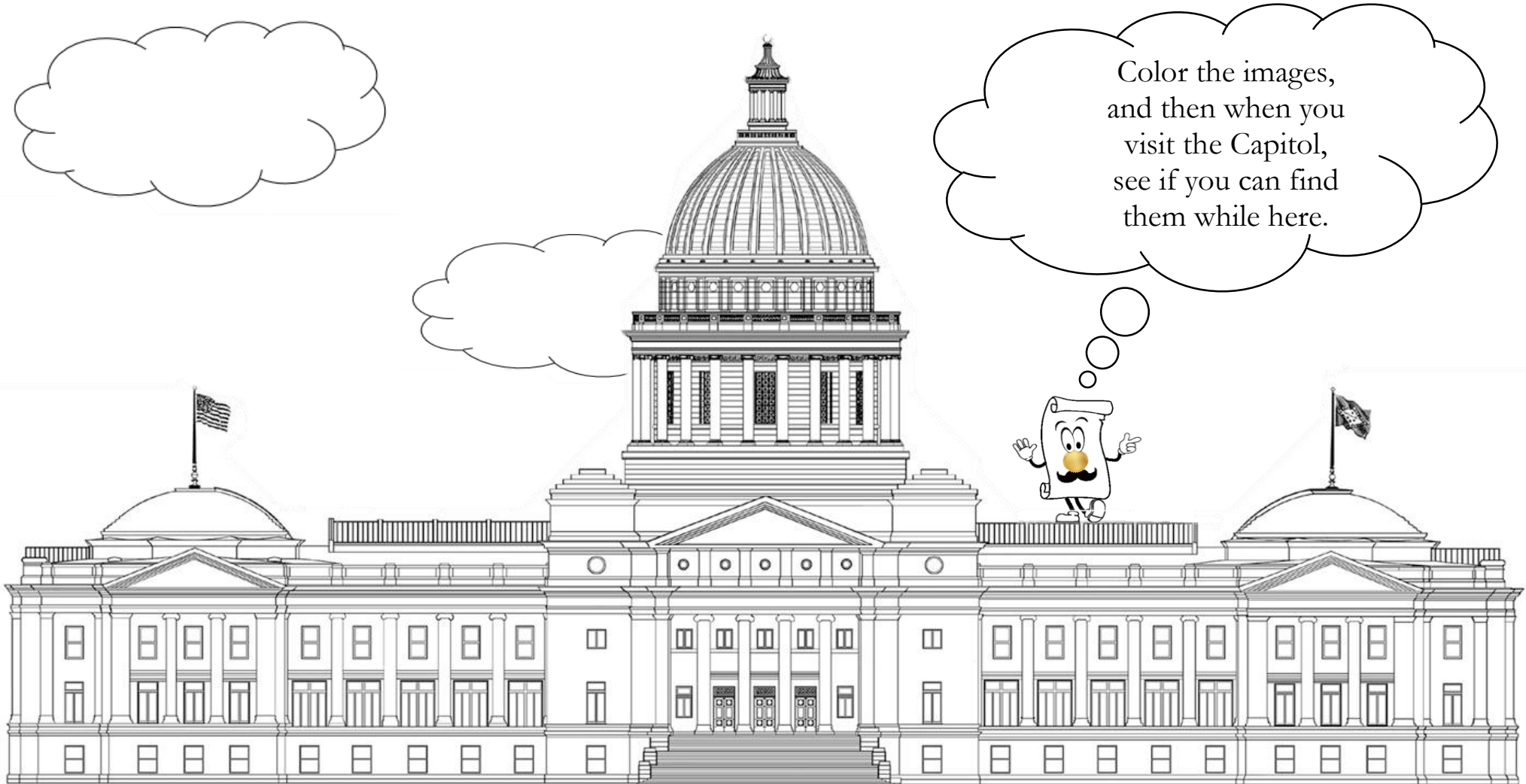


# What will you see, when you visit the Arkansas Capitol?

When you arrive at the Arkansas State Capitol, you will see a Neo-Classical style building that took 16 years to build from 1899 to 1915. The Capitol is where Legislators (*people who represent you*) meet to write and vote on bills (*bills are ideas people have*) that will hopefully become a law. If the bill passes both the House and Senate, it goes to the Governor who will sign the bill making it a law or veto (*will not sign*) it.

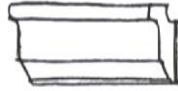

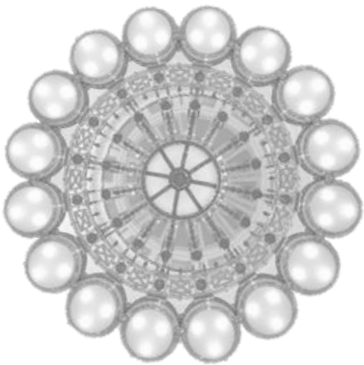

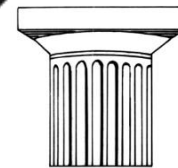
