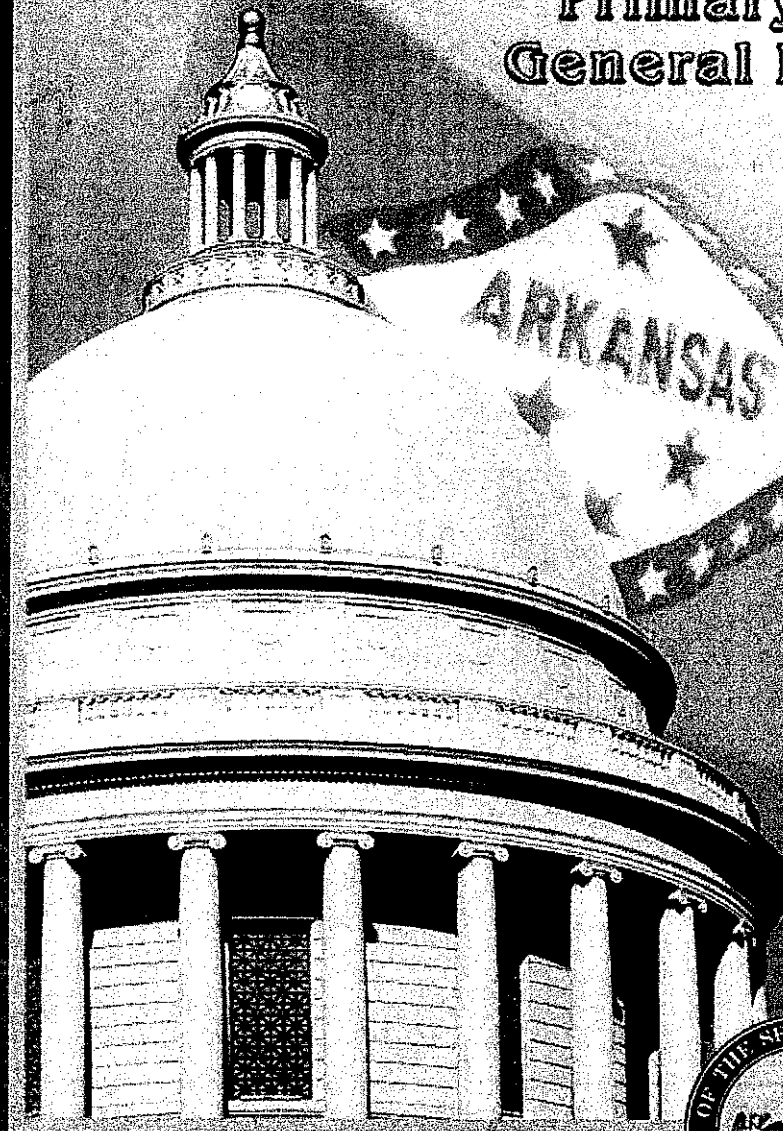

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## Glossary of Election Terms

Active Voter	A voter-registration designation indicating the voter is eligible to vote.
Inactive Voter	A classification used to designate a voter whose registration status is no longer current where they were registered and who has not attempted to re-register, voted, or appeared to vote at the address of record, or whom election officials have been unable.
Registered Voters	Persons who have registered pursuant to Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51. (Includes both Active and Inactive Voters in Arkansas.) The following voter registration "cut-off" dates were used to determine voter turnout: April 28, 2006 for the 2006 Primary and Non-Partisan Judicial Election May 19, 2006 for the 2006 Primary Run-off Election October 13, 2006 for the 2006 General and Non-Partisan Judicial Run-off Election
Overvote	Occurs when more selections are made than are permitted in a contest.
Undervote	Occurs when fewer selections are made than are permitted in a contest, including the choice to not vote for any candidate in a contest or any response to a ballot question.
Absentee Vote	A ballot applied for, issued and voted by a voter who will not vote on Election Day.
Early Vote	Vote cast during the fifteen (15) days before an election.
At Polls Vote	Vote cast at a location referred to as a "Polling Site or Polling place" on Election Day.
Precinct	Administrative division representing a geographic area to which voters have been assigned by their residing address for voting.
Polling Place	Facility staffed by workers and equipped with voting equipment at which persons cast ballots in person on Election Day.
Unopposed	Candidate who does not have an opponent in an election.
HAVA	The abbreviation for the Help America Vote Act of 2002. A copy of HAVA and additional information is available at <a href="http://www.eac.gov">www.eac.gov</a> .

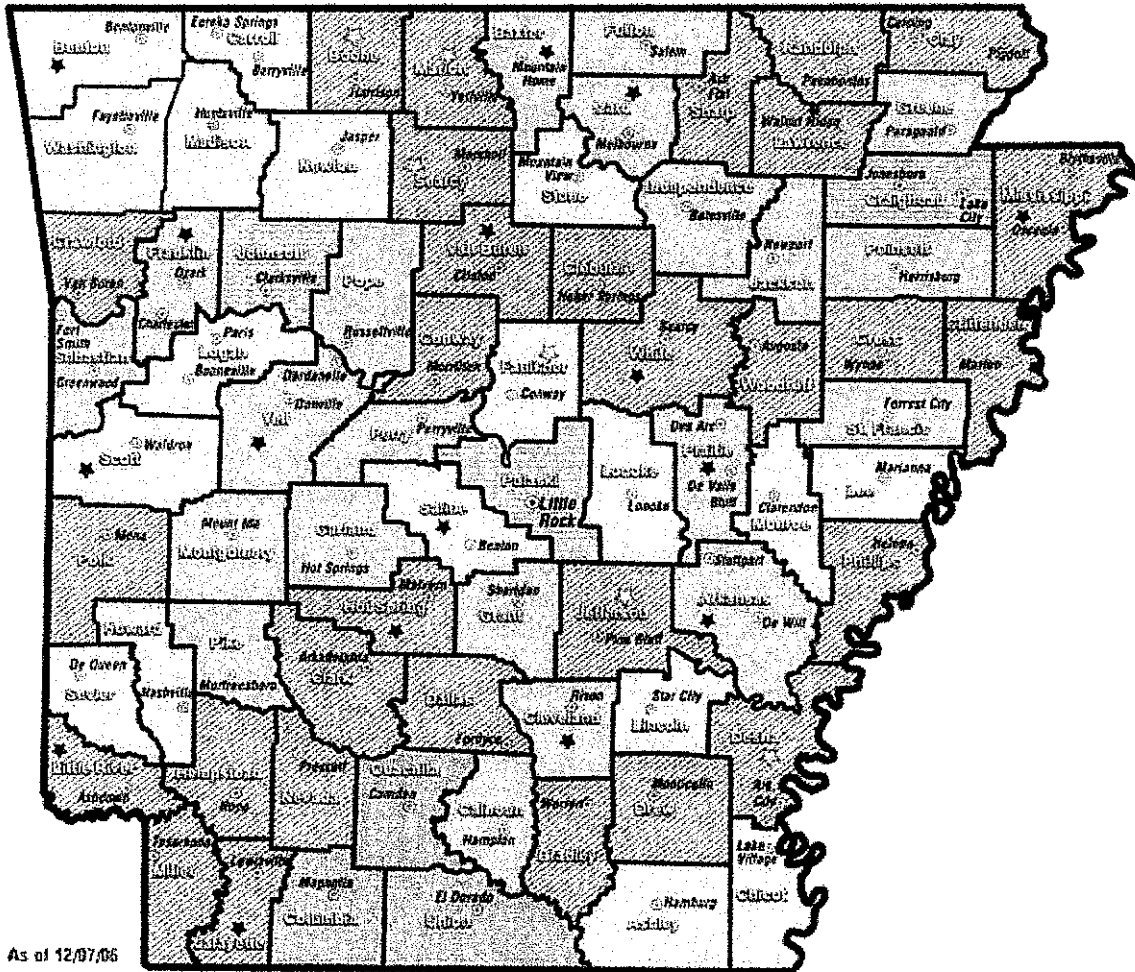
