PROCLAMATION

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME - GREETINGS:

A PROCLAMATION CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE OFFICE OF MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR DISTRICT 39. THIS PROCLAMATION SUPERCEDES THE PROCLAMATION ON THIS MATTER DATED AUGUST 22, 2005.

I, Mike Huckabee, Governor of Arkansas, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by Section 6 of Article V of the Arkansas Constitution and Arkansas Code Annotated §7-7-105, do hereby call a special election for the purpose of filling a vacancy in the office of member of the House of Representatives of the General Assembly for District 39, created by the resignation of the Honorable R. Wayne Dobbins. Pursuant to the provisions of the above-referenced statute the political party nominees shall be selected by a special primary election. Filing for candidacy in the special primary election will commence at 12:00 noon on Tuesday, August 23, 2005, at the office of the Secretary of State in Little Rock. The deadline for filing as a candidate in the special primary election will be 12:00 noon on Friday, September 2, 2005. Candidates must file their Political Practices Pledges with the Secretary of State in Little Rock by Friday, September 2, 2005, at 12:00 noon. Independent candidates must file their notices of candidacy, nomination petitions, and Political Practices Pledges with the office of the Secretary of State in Little Rock, by Friday, September 2, 2005, at 12:00 noon. The special primary election will be held on Tuesday, October 11, 2005. If necessary, a run-off special primary election will be held on Tuesday, November 1, 2005. Ballot certification should be completed by Wednesday, November 16, 2005. The special election to fill the vacancy in office of member of the House of Representatives of the General Assembly for District 39 shall be held in that part of Pulaski County that constitutes the district on Tuesday, December 13, 2005. The person selected on Tuesday, December 13, 2005, shall serve the remainder of the present term of office.
