### Instructions to Canvassers and Signers

- or any item of an appropriation bill or measure passed by the General Assembly by petition of 6% of legal voters. A proposed measure must be submitted at a regular election. Referendum petitions may be referred at special elections on voters or constitutional amendments by position of 10% of legal voters, or (b) order the referendum against any general act 1. The Arkansas Constitution gives Arkansas citizens the power to (a) initiate legislation by petition of 8% of the legal of the votes east upon such measure. petition of 15% of the registered voters. Any measure submitted to the people becomes law when approved by a majorit
- 2. Only registered voters may sign. All signatures must be in the signer's own handwriting and in the presence of the person circulating the petition. Each petition part should contain only the signatures of voters residing in a single county

Printed name, date of birth, residence, city or town of residence, and date of signing must be given. If a petition signer

- If the person knowingly:
- (A) Signs a name other than his or her name to a petition;
- (B) Signs his or her name more than one (1) time to a petition; or
- (C) Signs a petition when he or she is not legally entitled to sign the petition;
- (2) If the person acting as a canvasser, notary, sponsor as defined under § 79-101, or agent of a sponsor: (A) Signs a name other than his or her own to a petition;
- (B) Prints a name, address, or birth date other than his or her own to a petition unless the signor requires (C) Solicits or obtains a signature to a petition knowing that the person signing is not qualified to sign the assistance due to disability and the person complies with § 7-9-103;
- (F) Knowingly misrepresents the purpose and effect of the petition or the measure affected for the purpose (E) Accepts or pays money or anything of value for obtaining signatures on a petition when the person address is not included on the sponsor's list filed with the Secretary of State under § 7-9-681; or acting as a canvasser, sponsor, or agent of a sponsor knows that the person acting as a canvasser's name or (D) Knowingly pays a person any form of compensation in exchange for signing a petition as a petitioner;
- (3) If the person acting as a canvasser knowingly makes a false statement on a petition verification form; [or]
- (5) If the person activing as a sponsor files a petition or a part of a petition with the official charged with verifying the signatures knowing that the petition or part of the petition contains one (1) or more false or fraudulent signatures unless each false or fraudulent signature is clearly stricken by the sponsor before
